

# English and Reading Placement Guide

## REWRI 081 or READ 081

ACCUPLACER Score 26-40

**REWRI 081:** This course is a 10-credit linked precollege reading and writing course. It is designed for non-native English speakers with extra grammar support, paragraph writing skills, vocabulary, and reading skills.

**READ 081:** This course is a 5-credit precollege reading course for students who want to improve their reading skills. The course focuses on reading for comprehension and vocabulary development.

## REWRI 091, ENGL 091 or READ 091

ACCUPLACER Score 41-60 or DSP

**REWRI 091:** This course is a 10-credit linked precollege reading and writing course that prepares students for English 101 Plus or English 101. It is designated for non-native English speakers to work on written language skills and reading skills. Students develop reading strategies for challenging reading and write paragraphs and essays related to readings. Students also focus on sentence structure and appropriate word choice, punctuation, spelling, and usage.

**ENGL 091:** This course is a 5-credit precollege writing course that prepares students for English 101. The course focuses on how to structure and develop paragraphs and full length essays. Instructors also work with students on grammar issues.

**READ 091:** This course is a 5-credit precollege advanced level reading course that prepares students for college 100+ courses. It focuses on developing college reading skills. Topics of study include literal, inferential, and critical level comprehension, recall/study strategies, academic vocabulary, and information literacy.

## ENGL 101 or ENGL 101 Plus

Multiple assessment measures place students into these courses

**English 101:** This is a 5-credit English 101 course. The course focuses on college essay writing and complex readings/topics, with limited focus on grammar basics. Students develop good drafting and revision strategies for college composition.

**English 101Plus:** This is a 10-credit English 101 course with extra support. The course focuses on college essay writing and complex readings / topics, with limited focus on grammar basics. Students develop good drafting and revision strategies for college composition.



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
