

- If your Selective Service status is not confirmed on your FAFSA, you must provide proof of Selective Service registration or proof you entered the United States after your 26th birthday and were, therefore, not required to register with Selective Service. Find the application at **sss.gov.**

- Provide proof of regained eligibility for financial aid from the Department
 of Education if you are in

 loan or owe a repayment on
 a federal grant.
