AMOUNT: Fifteen applicants will receive a 15-credit tuition waiver for Fall Quarter 2019.

WHO MAY APPLY:

- Students who will be attending full-time (taking <u>at least 12 credits</u>) at Highline College in the Fall of 2019, and who have a <u>minimum high school or college GPA of 3.0 or better</u>.
- Previous recipients may apply. (No student may receive more than <u>two</u> overall, however.) Greater consideration will be given to new applicants.
- Running Start students, non-resident student status, and international students are <u>not</u> eligible.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Selection will be based upon your essay responses, cumulative grade point, etc. (see below)
- Winning applicants will be notified of their status by email by Thursday, August 29, 2019.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- Submit the following:
 - A. This **form**, filled in with your information.
- B. **Separate pages** with answers to the following. Each essay response should not exceed one page in length. These should be <u>typed and double-spaced</u>.
 - **Part I** Describe your **educational goal(s)** here at Highline and in the years beyond.
 - **Part II**—Tell us about your personal journey (story) to how you got to Highline College.
 - **Part III**—How do you plan to use your knowledge, skills, and abilities from HC to contribute to Highline, local, and/or global communities.
 - C. A copy of your **transcript**, reflecting grades from your most recent school experience. Unofficial is acceptable. Please include transcript from previous college/university if applicable. (<u>Be sure your cumulative GPA is displayed</u> on your HCC transcript; check to be sure your cumulative grade info has not been cut off at the sides or bottom of the page, if you print out an unofficial copy.) **If you do not submit a transcript you will be disqualified.**
- No late or incomplete applications will be considered. Essays that exceed page/word limit will not be considered. Transcripts that do not show a cumulative GPA will not be considered.

LIMITATIONS:

• Students receiving other need-based financial aid in the form of tuition waivers will <u>not</u> benefit by receiving a Highline Achievement Scholarship. When other state or federal financial aid is involved, the addition of a Highline Scholarship might result in an over-award. If so, the need-based financial aid would be reduced.
