- ☐ Give the advisor/DSO at your current school the acceptance letter from Highline College
- ☐ Complete your current school's exit requirements
- ☐ Work with the advisor/DSO at your current school to get your SEVIS record transferred to Highline College

## Traveling Outside of the US

- ☐ Tell Highline College about your plans to travel outside of the United States prior to orientation
  - ☐ Pick up your Highline I-20 from the ISP office with travel signature
- OR
- ☐ Give ISP office your mailing address to send your Highline I-20 with travel signature
- ☐ Arrive back in the US before orientation

- If you are not traveling outside of the US prior to new student orientation, Highline College will give you your new I-20 during the second week of the quarter.

- ☐ Arrive to Orientation on time
  - ☐ Previous School I-20 and Acceptance Letter
  - ☐ Passport and Visa
  - ☐ U.S. Address
- ☐ Attend everyday of Orientation
  - ☐ Register for classes\*\*
  - ☐ Activate Highline Email account\*\*
  - ☐ Take placement test(s)\*\*

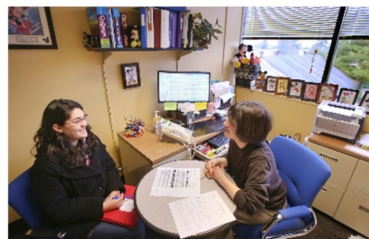
**Academic Success Centers** include the Tutoring Center, Writing Center, and Math Resources Center. They provide tutoring for many different classes for free.
