- \Rightarrow IGCSE Grade E or better in English
- \Rightarrow Completion of GCE A-level, O-level or N-level
- \Rightarrow Complete Kaplan High Intermediate Level
- \Rightarrow If you have studied in high school in English speaking countries or attended English speaking International School, this may be waived. Submit your school transcript to check the eligibility.
