PLAN TO TAKE MATH 111, MATH 141, OR MATH 146 BUT PLACED A COURSE BELOW? COULD YOU USE EXTRA SUPPORT IN A MATH CLASS?

MATHP 111, COLLEGE ALGEBRA PLUS EXTRA SUPPORT IS:

A 10 credit corequisite course for business and social science pathways: 5 credits count for a college math requirement (QSR), 5 credits towards developmental math support. This course is designed for students who need Math 111, are eligible for Math 91, and who do not need any other math course having Math 98 as a prerequisite.

MATHP 141, PRECALCULUS PLUS EXTRA SUPPORT IS:

A 10 credit corequisite course for students going into STEM programs: 5 credits count for college math requirement (QSR), 5 credits towards developmental math support. Designed for students needing Math 141 who place into math 98 who have successfully completed an intermediate algebra course or feel they need extra support to be successful in 141.

MATHP 146, INTRO TO STATISTICS PLUS EXTRA SUPPORT IS:

A 10 credit corequisite course for health and social sciences pathways: 5 credits count for college math requirement (QSR), 5 credits towards developmental math support. This course is designed for students who need Math 146, are eligible for Math 91, and who do not need any other math course having Math 98 as a prerequisite.
