STEPS TO APPLY

All steps must be completed prior to the first day of the quarter.

- Apply for admissions to Highline College online: admissions.highline.edu
- Activate MyHighline account

You will receive emails with your Student ID number (SID) and activation code.

- **Visit Highline's Placement and Testing Center to assess English and Math placement** (Building 1)
 - Take ACCUPLACER Reading (minimum score of 80 or 253) or bring Smarter Balance ELA/Literacy scores 3 or 4. (COMPASS Reading score of 77 or above will continue to be accepted through December 2018.)
 - Math placement is needed for math and science courses (not required for RS eligibility.)
- Submit the Running Start Enrollment Packet to the High School Programs office (Student Services Building 6, 2nd floor) Includes:
 - □ Running Start Program Application completed and signed
 - □ Unofficial High School transcript (2.0 min cumulative GPA)
 - □ Running Start Enrollment Verification Form completed and signed
 - □ ACCUPLACER Reading score of 80, or Smarter Balance ELA/Literacy scores (3 or 4)

Optional Fee Waiver (If Eligible) due by the 10th day of the quarter

- Required Fee Waiver documentation: a) School District free/reduced lunch letter b) Fee Waiver Application signed by high school official, or c) verification of foster youth status
- Check Highline Email for Welcome letter and steps to enroll

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- I am responsible to meet all high school graduation requirements and to determine how high school and HC courses meet two-year and four-year college requirements.
- College classes may include moral, cultural, and political content that may differ from my values. I will not be exempt from class
 participation based on my or my family's objections.
- I will register and/or withdraw from my HC classes in accordance with HC procedures and deadlines.
- The grades and withdrawals I earn at HC are part of my permanent college and high school transcripts.
- I am aware that HC is on a quarterly academic calendar that may not align with the high school calendar (breaks.)
- To maintain academic standards I must earn a cumulative HC 2.0 GPA to avoid probation/suspension.
- I will comply with the policy and procedures outlined in Student Rights and Responsibilities, including academic integrity.
- Each quarter I must complete an Enrollment Verification Form to register for classes. (Forged signatures will be referred to the Student Conduct Officer.)
- I must utilize my HC email for official HC communication.
- If absent from class for any reason, I will contact my instructors for potential arrangements (if allowed.)
- I am ineligible to play on an official HC sports team.
- Parents and guardians do not have access to my records and registration, unless I sign a release to the Registration office.
- I will pay the following, or be blocked from registration and risk being sent to collection:
 - \circ All non-tuition costs (fees, books, supplies and transportation)
 - Tuition for pre-college courses (below the 100 level)
 - o Tuition in excess of approved credit maximum
