WHAT WE DO

We don't just help with English assignments; our consultants are excellent at helping writers from many different classes and styles. They act as experienced readers and writing mentors, and they give suggestions to help you improve as a writer.

Whether a student needs help understanding an assignment, developing ideas, revising a paper using faculty feedback, or addressing grammar issues, the consultant will have a conversation with you and help you develop strategies for completing the current piece of writing as well as support to improve your writing overall.

The consultant will not "fix" your paper for you. Learning happens over time, and the consultant will support you through your progress rather than doing the work for you.

Each week, consultants also lead workshops about specific writing topics, such as sentence structure, source documentation, and self-assessment. These workshops are group-based and hands-on.
